The next phase of development has started at Goat Island. This will create a new boatyard area with facilities for boat maintenance and construction.

The Port Authority has appointed Breedon Hebrides to construct a bespoke boat washdown area at the western end of the reclaimed area. This will have a concrete surface and specialist drainage to catch all debris and avoid pollution of the harbour waters.

Marine Engineering Workshop

3b Construction have started to build the new Marine Engineering Workshop. The first task is to install foundation piles; this will be quite noisy but should only take a few days. The piles are re-used oil drill casings. This is now normal engineering practice, as the casings are very strong. It is also very sustainable, as re-using existing products avoids the carbon emissions with making new steel.
